## Exterior Deck Railing: The Basics

Integrity - Responsibility - Innovation

Minimum Height of Railing is $42^{\prime \prime}$ when a deck is above 6 feet high
Minimum Height of Railing is 36 " when a deck is below 6 feet high
Stair Height of Railing is 34 " to $42^{\prime \prime}$
Handrail must be 2" away from a wall
Handrails must be graspable in a continuous fashion until top and bottom
Single family handrails are allowed to end with a newel post at bottom and turns
No gap opening can be larger than 4"
All Rail systems must comply to concentrated load tests
Railing is not required on stairs 3 rise or less
Railing is required on any height above 2 feet
2 handrails are required on widths greater than 43 "
All ramps require 2 handrails
Wall mount handrails (brackets) must be max 47" apart and 12" max from ends
All guard Rails cannot have a climbable portion between $5.5^{\prime \prime}$ and $36^{\prime \prime}$
All glass must be tempered and stamped and $\min 5 \mathrm{~mm}$
